

Minutes of the Bridger Canyon Rural Fire District Meeting

Bridger Canyon Women's Club and volunteers had a work session to maintain flowers in front of Station 1. The Board thanked Susan and Gary Andrew for their 10+ years volunteering and maintaining the flowers.


New Business: Chief Mather reported residents are working on generator shed as their schedules allow between their outside employment. Looking for a volunteer building maintenance position was discussed. Joanne Desch reported the adaptive equipment in the Brackett Creek Station has been well used and donations have been received in appreciation for their availability.

Tom Elfmont spoke on the issue of recreational burning on private land in the District and asked the Board to endorse a ban on such burning. No action was taken.

Gary Andrews spoke on the need for an Auxillary to maintain supplies at the Station and keep aware of needed maintenance issues. No action was taken.

Dan Knapp made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Joni Balian. Motion approved.
